The Ascension of the Lord Year B - 11th & 12th May 2024 LITURGY OF THE WORD

Entrance Antiphon (at the Vigil Mass)

Your kingdoms of the earth, sing to God; Praise the Lord, who ascends above the highest heavens; his majesty and might are in the skies alleluia.

Entrance Antiphon (at the Mass during Day)

Men of Galilee, why gaze in wonder at the heavens? This Jesus whom you saw ascending into heaven will return as you saw him go, alleluia.

FIRST READING

A reading from the Acts of the Apostles (1:1-11)

(Why are you standing here looking into the sky? Jesus has been taken into heaven).

In my earlier work, Theophilus, I dealt with everything Jesus had done and taught from the beginning until the day he gave his instructions to the apostles he had chosen through the Holy Spirit, and was taken up to heaven. He had shown himself alive to them after his Passion by many demonstrations: for forty days he had continued to appear to them and tell them about the kingdom of God. When he had been at table with them, he had told them not to leave Jerusalem, but to wait there for what the Father had promised. 'It is,' he had said, 'what you have heard me speak about: John baptised with water but you, not many days from now, will be baptised with the Holy Spirit.'

Now having met together, they asked him, 'Lord, has the time come? Are you going to restore the kingdom to Israel?' He replied, 'It is not for you to know times or dates that the Father has decided by his own authority, but you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you, and then you will be my witnesses not only in Jerusalem but throughout Judaea and Samaria, and indeed to the ends of the earth.'

As he said this he was lifted up while they looked on, and a cloud took him from their sight. They were still staring into the sky when suddenly two men in white were standing near them and they said, 'Why are you men from Galilee standing here looking into the sky? Jesus who has been taken up from you into heaven, this same Jesus will come back in the same way as you have seen him go there.'

Reflection:

A new and wider vision

Jesus is presented as ascending to heaven from the top of Mount Olivet. A mountain is a place of vision. On a mountain top we feel somehow closer to God. Indeed, we feel we are in the presence of God.

A story is told about a man who had lived all his life in a clearing in the forest. The clearing was only about 100 yards across and was hemmed in by trees. The man's world was extremely enclosed. He had very little concept of space or distance. In such a world even comparatively small objects can appear larger than life because of one's nearness to them.

One day an explorer took him out of the forest and led him up to the top of a high mountain. He couldn't get over the wide open spaces that existed beyond the forest, the immensity of the sky, and the vastness of the horizon. He was amazed at discovering that a world existed in which there were no trees and very little vegetation. He was like a little child in his excitement. He was so happy that he wanted to remain up there.

But of course he had to go back down to his small, enclosed, narrow world. However, he never forgot his visit to the mountain top. It had a wonderful effect on him. It helped him to take a broader view of life, especially when things were becoming too much for him and the world was closing in on him.

When the time came for Jesus to leave this world, he took his apostles up to the top of the Mount Olives. He was returning to the Father. He was going to glory. As he ascended he directed their eyes upwards, towards the place where he was going. But he also pointed their eyes outwards. He showed them that there was a great world out there waiting to hear the Gospel. He gave them the task of bringing the Gospel to that vast world, and promised to send them the Holy Spirit to equip them for that task.

The apostles liked it on the hill, so much that they wanted to remain there. But a voice called them back to reality: 'Men of Galilee, why do you stand here looking up into the heavens?' Even though they had to go back down into the real world, their lives would never be the same.

This feast is as much about journey lies. It is a goal and a destiny which defies even our imagination. It gives us a new and wider vision. It pushes out our horizons beyond the boundaries of this world. It gives an eternal dimension to our lives.

Jesus went back to the source, the Alpha and Omega. This is the meaning of his Ascension. It is not a journey into outer space, but a journey home. His Ascension does not represent his removal from the earth, but his constant presence everywhere on earth. During his earthly ministry he could only be in one place at a time. But now that he is united with God, he is present wherever God is present; and that is everywhere.

We live in the hope that the words of Jesus will come true to us: 'Where I am, you too shall be.' Meanwhile we have a task to do: to preach the Gospel and to be his witness in the world.
