Reflection:

Belief in God

The following prayer was found on the body of young soldier, killed in action during World War 1.

Look, God, I've never spoken to you before, but now I just want to say 'hello'. They told me you didn't exist, and like a fool I believed them. But last night I looked up at the sky from the shell hole. When I saw the beauty of the stars, and thought how big the universe is, I knew they were telling a lie.

I wonder if you will shake hands with me when we meet? Somehow I feel you will understand all my failures. Strange how I had to come to this horrible place to get to know you. What was I doing before this? There isn't much more to say, but I'm sure glad I got to know you today. I feel the zero hour will soon be here. This is going to be a horrible fight. Who knows but I may come to your house tonight.

I'm crying! Fancy me crying! I never thought this could happen to me. I have to go now. Strange, since I met you, I'm no longer afraid to die.

It was sad that the young soldier got to know God so late. But better late than never, as they say. When we allow ourselves to get disconnected from God, an enormous loss occurs. The author, Salman Rushdie, said, 'When I was young, I was religious in an unthinking way. Now I am not, but I am conscious of a space where God was.'

It's lonely not knowing God. People seek security in wealth, possessions, connections and so on. But God is the ultimate refuge. Those who surrender to God, begin to taste the peace that passes all understanding. Human beings cannot be happy unless they are virtuous, and they can't be virtuous without God.

Jesus has lifted the veil on the mystery of God. We are no longer far away. We have been brought into the family of God. We have a Father who cares about us, a Brother who died for us, and a Comforter who guides us along the path of life eternal.
